Mercy Ship is currently docked and serving in the south of Congo. New Sight joined forces with the biggest floating hospital in the world by sending Henri from our hospital in the north to work on the ship in March. For 6 weeks, Henri was part of a brilliant eye team consulting and operating on hundreds of patients. In addition, collaboration with the Ministry of Health and other health organisations was strengthened to improve the health care infrastructure and future eye care provision of the country. The ship will leave Congo this May / June for maintenance before sailing to bless another country.


